Most Valuable Player Awards Program is created.

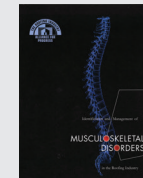

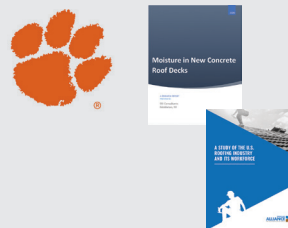
